

Sights along the Walking Trail

On the mountain stream levee – Do you notice the changes along the trail? The sunny position and the constantly changing soil are challenging for even the humblest of plants. In heavy rainfall, a torrential stream will again carry debris into the valley, depositing it now here, now there, hollowing out a channel, carrying away a shrub or a tree. That's life on the mountain stream levee, it constantly changes.

Remarkable trees – What do you feel when you see a special old tree? Old, thick trees are a real rarity and all the more desirable for that. Trees lose their life energy over time, but it comes back again and again. Fungi, lichens, mosses, beetles, spiders, ants, birds... try to find them on rotting trunks! It is worth stopping by the Logar lime, the Plesnik elm or the giant juniper.

Woodcutter's hut – a safe shelter for a deserved rest. Hard work of woodcutters with an axe and a hand-saw, meagre food, sleeping in a bunk bed, covered only with leaves or spruce branches accompanied forest workers during cutting and transporting of timber.

Wooden chute for wood transport – Can you imagine this adrenaline transport of wood? Timber was transported from distant forests down into the valleys using wooden chutes, mostly during the winter. In spring, when the water levels were high due to the melting snow, logs were floated down the Savinja to the sawmills. Once the wood had been cut, the boards were used to make rafts which were then floated down the Savinja, Sava and even the Danube to the Black Sea.

Waterfalls – Enjoy the shower of water drops! Rinka, Palenk, Ras-tovški and Sušica waterfalls are just some names of the majestic images of falling water in Logar Valley. They change with the seasons and by making friends with torrential streams.

People – Locals have tuned in their lives with nature. Nature was constantly observed during hard and exhausting work. Locals passed on their experiences and beliefs to others through stories, fairy tales and tales. In this way, they became more connected to all living beings and could understand the natural phenomena.

Animals – Listen carefully to nature and animals will reveal themselves to you; from the quietest to the fastest. Every living thing has its role and place in nature, including humans.

Alpine plants have adapted to having the ground constantly cut from under their roots. Beautiful and humble, they grow on rubble that is shifted by weathering, torrential waters, avalanches,...

Forests – Humans understand too little and interfere too much with the dynamic balance of forests. A forest is not just trees, it is a community of living beings. Much is hidden from our eyes, but we can perceive the coordinated action of all the parts of the forest. In a forest community, only constant adaptation is permanent.

Beech and charcoal burning – everything flows in the circle of life. The natural forests of the Logar Valley were predominantly beech. In the 19th century, beech wood was used to make charcoal, so the forests were cut down, changing the image of the valley. After a hundred years, the beech tree is returning to its natural habitat, and the charcoal burning has been preserved to show and preserve the tradition.

Golica v Krejdi – The torrent has revealed the events of the geological past like a detective. The structure of the hillside along the stream reveals that, after cold periods, a glacier deposited coarse-grained rubble here. During warm periods, fine clays were created at the bottom of the lake.

Logarski Kot Herdsman's Hut – Stand still beneath the walls of Planjava, breathe in the scent of the mountains! Perhaps with the smell of the fire from the hearth, you will also breathe in the scent of the past, and spark your memory to help you recall something that makes you sit back and calm down.

Rinka Waterfall – Do you know the secrets of the source of the Savinja? Below Okrešelj, several springs join together in the Kotovec riverbed, which plunges 90 metres into the Rinka waterfall. Shortly afterwards, it disappears into the gravel and reappears in the lower part of the valley at the source of the Črna spring. When the waters of the Kotovec and the Črna are joined by the Jezera stream from Matkov kot, they flow on like the river Savinja.



Dear visitors, you are welcome because you:

- park in the designated areas;
- only walk on the marked paths;
- take your rubbish home or put it in the rubbish bins;

Along the Logarska Dolina Walking Trail, you will stop at the most interesting points on your own or in a group, accompanied by an experienced guide, and learn about the glacial valley, the forest, wildlife, birds, the life of the woodcutters, about charcoal-making and other interesting facts that show the remarkable connection between people and nature over the centuries.

The walk along the trail takes 2-3 hours one way. The total length of the trail is 7 km, ending at the Rinka Waterfall, but you can choose a shorter version.

Walk safely on the Logarska Dolina Walking Trail!

Watch out for slippery wooden bridges, roots and rock. Be careful when crossing the roads – cyclists, cars.

We wish you many enjoyable experiences in Logarska dolina Landscape Park.

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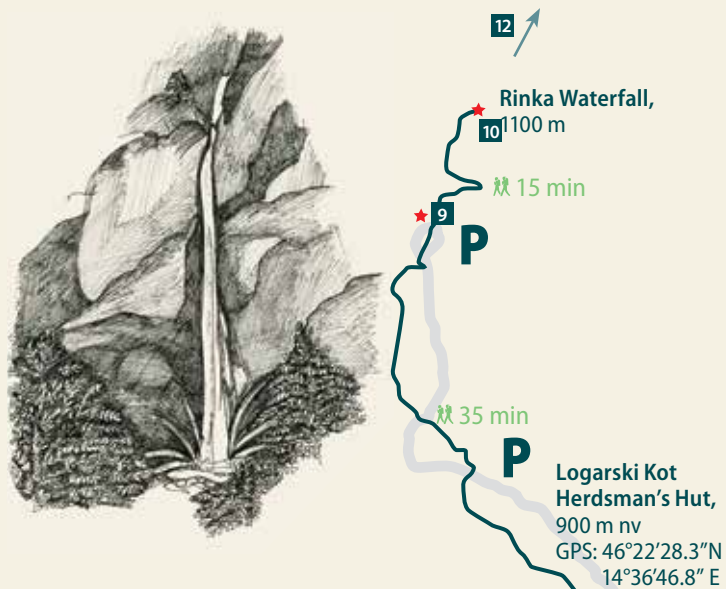
